PRIVATE PILOT LICENSE (PPL)

Admission Requirements:

- Minimum 17 years of age
- English proficiency test
- Category 3 Canadian Medical Examination

Program Requirements:

- At least 45 hours of flight training
- Minimum of 17 hours dual (with instructor)
- Minimum of 12 hours pilot in command (solo)
- 40 hours of Ground School
- At least 60% on written exam (PPAER)
- Successful completion of flight test

Approximate Costs:

- Ground School - \$900.00
 - Textbook package and tools - \$500.00
 - Exams and Licensing Fees - \$1000.00
 - Dual Cessna 172M @17 hours – \$5015.00 (\$295/hour)
 - Solo Cessna 172M @12 hours – \$2760.00 (\$230/hour)
 - Solo Time Building @16 hours - \$3680.00 (\$230/hour)
 - Additional briefings/ground instruction @10 hours - \$650.00 – (\$65/hour)
- = \$14,505.00 before tax**

*Minimum is 45 flight hours – but the average is approx. 65-80 flight hours

*Note – pricing is approximate and varies for each student based on time/progress. Taxes not included.

Approximate Timelines:

-PPL can be completed in as little as a 2-3 months *if* It is a full-time commitment (mon-fri 8:30am-5pm). For most learners however, they are balancing school, work, family and extracurricular activities – and the timeline is extended to about 12 months time.
