COMMERCIAL PILOT LICENSE (CPL)

Admission Requirements:

- -Minimum 18 years of age
- -Valid Private Pilot License (PPL) holder
- -Category 1 Canadian Medical Examination

Program Requirements:

- -At least 200 hours of flight training
- -Minimum of 35 hours dual (with instructor)
- -Minimum of 100 hours pilot in command (solo)
- -80 hours of Ground School
- -At least 60% on written exam (CPAER)
- -Successful completion of flight test

Approximate Costs:

- -Ground School \$1200.00
- -Exams and Licensing Fees \$1000.00
- -Dual Cessna 172M @35 hours \$10,675.00 (\$305/hour)
- -Solo Cessna 172M @30 hours \$6900.00 (\$230/hour)
- -Additional briefings/ground instruction @10 hours \$750.00 (\$75/hour)
 - =\$20,525.00 before tax
- -Additional Solo Time Building @42 hours \$9660.00 (\$230/hour) to reach min req'd 200 hrs flight time
- *Minimum is 200 flight hours but the average is typically higher (also depends on hrs taken to complete PPL)
- *Note pricing is approximate and varies for each student based on time/progress. Taxes not included.

Approximate Timelines:

-CPL can be completed in as little as a 6 months *if* it is a full-time commitment (Mon-Fri 8:30am-5pm). For most learners however, they are balancing school, work, family and extracurricular activities — and the timeline is extended to about 12 months time.
